





Dr. Reese earned her Master's Degree in Community Counseling from McDaniel College in Westminster, MD and her Ph.D. in Counselor Education from George Washington University in Washington, D.C. Dr. Reese's research "A Qualitative Study of Gang Desistance in Former Gang Members" explored the thoughts and feelings of former gang members to better understand their thought process in deciding to leave their gangs.
